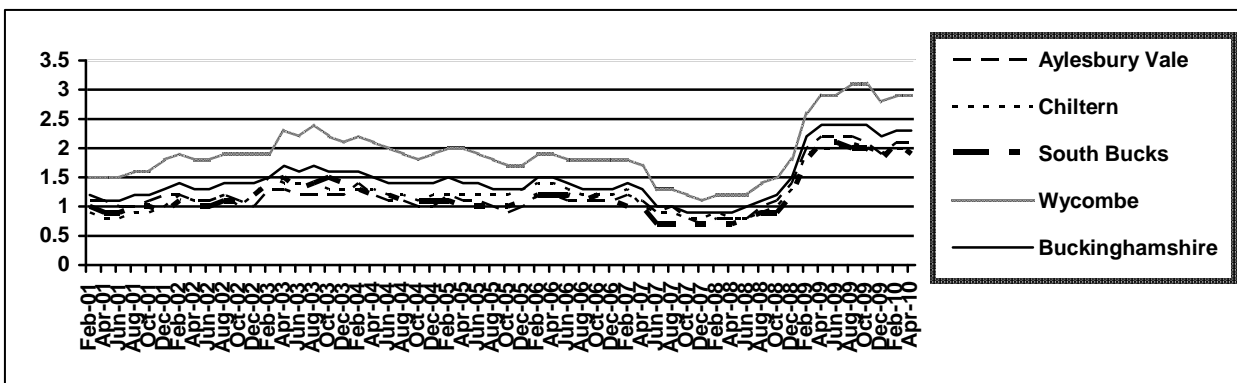

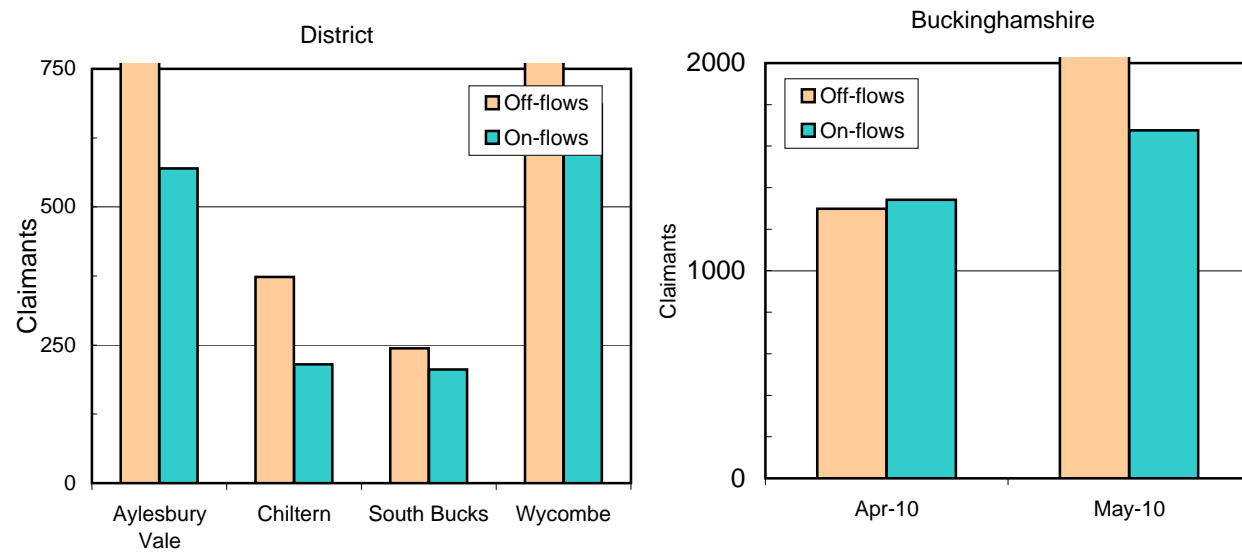

**Definition of Unemployed Claimants:**

The unemployed claimant count includes all people claiming Unemployment Benefit, Income Support or National Insurance Credits at Unemployment Benefit Offices on the day of the monthly count who satisfy the conditions for claiming benefit.

Students who are returning to full time education, and temporarily stopped workers, that is those who had a job on the day of the count, but were temporarily suspended and claiming benefits, are not included in the count. Full time education leavers aged under 18 years have been excluded since October 1988.
