Ashgrove Picnic Site	Little Missenden	1.70	4.20	Part of Green Belt Estate. Picnic area within Chilterns AONB. Links to accessible land owned by the Forestry Commission.
Bacombe Hill	Wendover	25.30	62.52	Part of Green Belt Estate. High profile site on Chilterns escarpment. Site of Special Scientific Interest for wildlife. Designated a Local Nature Reserve. Also contains Scheduled Ancient Monuments. Part of a popular access network on the escarpment overlooking Aylesbury Vale. Ridgeway National Trail runs through. Part classified as Open Access Land.
Black Park Country Park	Wexham	216.51	535.00	Mature mixed woodland Country Park with lake, open area, café, childrens play area, 400 space car park and over 14 miles of tracks with excellent access. LNR & SSSI. Pine woods, lowland heath and mixed deciduous woodland on acidic soils. Over 414,000 visitors per year. Part of the Langley Park Estate.
Brill Walks	Brill	2.90	7.17	Part of Green Belt Estate. Area of grazed grassland and mature trees on edge of Brill Village. Well used by local community.
Brill Windmill	Brill	0.01	0.02	C17th Century Grade II listed post windmill. Well known north Bucks landmark and highly valued historic feature.
Canal Car Park	Aston Clinton	0.50	1.24	Small car park on edge of the Highway. Gives access to the Wendover Arm of the Grand Union Canal.
Caps Wood (including picnic site)	Denham	9.50	23.47	Part of Green Belt Estate. Area of woodland split by road scheme. Small car park and picnic area.
Captains Wood	Chesham	11.00	27.18	Part of Green Belt Estate. Designated as a Local Nature Reserve. Site of high wildlife value close to built up area of Chesham. Within the Chilterns AONB.

Cholesbury Camp	Cholesbury	0.42	1.04	Part of Green Belt Estate. Area of woodland and scrub on Iron Age camp Scheduled Ancient Monument.
Cobblers Pits (Catsbrains Estate)	Aston Clinton	6.31	15.59	Part of Green Belt Estate. Small woodland within tenanted farmland linking to the Wendover Arm of the Grand Union Canal and close to Green Park.
Cockshoots Wood Picnic Site	Wendover	0.21	0.52	Small car park/picnic site on free lease offered by the landowner. Within the Chilterns AONB. Good links to surrounding Rights of Way network.
Coombe Hill Monument	Ellesborough	0.01	0.02	Buckinghamshire Boer War Memorial. Owned and maintained by BCC but within National Trust land on very popular viewpoint in Chilterns Escarpment. Listed Structure.
Cublington Spinney & Airport Monument	Cublington	0.28	0.69	Part of Smallholdings Estate. Created to commemorate defeat of airport proposal. Small car park and walk.
Denham Country Park	Denham	27.92	69.00	Small wetland site hosting the Colne Valley Park visitor centre and Groundwork Thames Valley. Situated close to the M40 with the Grand Union Canal, River Colne and River Misbourne mature woodland and wet meadows. Car parking for 100 cars. Small café run by the Colne Valley Partnership, annually 56,500 visitors.
Deep Mill Pond	Little Missenden	0.25	0.62	Pond situated adjacent to the Highway. Local historic and wildlife interest. No public access but visible as a feature from the road. Within Chilterns AONB.
Farnham Common Wood	Hedgerley	2.00	4.94	Part of Green Belt Estate. Small triangular area of woodland near road junction. Short path created through the site.
Gotts Monument	Chalfont St Peter	0.01	0.01	Stone & brick obelisk (C18th or C19th) situated in the grounds of the National Society of Epilepsy headquarters.
Grangelands and the Rifle Range	Great & Little Kimble	16.20	40.03	Part of Green Belt Estate. Site of Special Scientific Interest for wildlife. Within Chilterns AONB. Within an area popular for visitors linking with National Trust land. Ridgeway National Trail runs through. Classified as Open Access Land.

Hampden Monument	Prestwood	0.01	0.02	Part of Green Belt Estate. Stone monument to John Hampden within small maintained access/viewing area. Within Chilterns AONB.
Hog and Hollowhill Woods	Medmenham	33.00	81.54	Part of Green Belt Estate. Part is a Site of Special Scientific Interest and Chilterns Beechwoods European Special Area for Conservation. Within Chilterns AONB. No car park but Rights of Way and informal access routes through the wood. Links with site owned by the Woodland Trust.
Holtspur Picnic Site	Wooburn Green	0.05	0.12	Green Belt Estate. Car park and picnic area adjacent to road.
Kingsbridge Picnic Site	Stewkley	0.35	0.86	Part of Smallholdings Estate. Car park and picnic area created to allow access to statutory and permissive access routes and memorial plantation. Within an area otherwise devoid of countryside access opportunities.
Kingsbridge River Walk/Farm Trail	Stewkley	0.00	0.00	Permissive trail created around former Smallholdings farms (now sold but access route retained) to provide countryside access opportunity from Kingsbridge Picnic Site.
Long Spinney (Burcott Hall Farm)	Wing	4.27	10.55	Part of Smallholdings Estate. In-hand woodland adjacent to former County Farm. Wet site with good wildlife interest. Access route gives local community access to countryside.
Langley Park Country Park	Wexham	66.77	165.00	Grade 2 historic parkland with Brownian landscapes. Subject to £3.1m HLF restoration programme. Mature secondary oak woodland, open grass vistas, views to Windsor Castle, extensive Edwardian Rhododendron collection and arboretum, annually 92,200 visitors. Part of the Langley Park Estate.
Missenden Abbey Parkland	Great Missenden	21.15	52.26	Part of Green Belt Estate. Tenanted grazing land of high landscape value. Registered Historic Parkland. Access routes maintained to facilitate public access. Important access site for local community. Within Chilterns AONB.
Northmoor Hill Woods (including picnic site)	Denham	8.80	21.74	Part of Green Belt Estate. High wildlife interest. Also contains site of geological interest. Designated as a Local Nature Reserve close to built up areas. Car Park and picnic area.

Pavis, Black & Northhill Woods	Drayton Beauchamp	34.40	85.00	Part of Green Belt Estate. Mature woodland on the Chilterns Escarpment, within the AONB. No car park but access route throughout the site, including the Ridgeway National Trail.
Rowley Woods & Rowley Farm Trail	Wexham	36.73	90.76	Part of Green Belt Estate. In hand woodlands adjacent to Black Park Country Park. The woods and the farm trail give access to an extended area for visitors. Part of the Langley Park Estate.
Shipton Bridge Picnic Site	Winslow	0.12	0.30	Small parking area and picnic site created on former highway following road straightening scheme.
Spade Oak Picnic Site and Spade Oak Meadow	Little Marlow	0.30	0.74	Part of Green Belt Estate. Car park and picnic area giving access to the nearby River Thames and restored gravel pits plus single field adjacent to the River Thames (Thames Path National Trail) used extensively for recreation.
Stockgrove Country Park	Soulbury	32.40	80.06	Visitor centre offices, car park for 60 cars lake, ancient woodland conifer plantations, meadows and heath. Part of a larger estate totalling 260 acres. Shared ownership with Central Beds Council. The site is managed by the Greensand Trust on behalf of both councils.
Stanbridge Picnic Site (links to Church Farm Trail below)	Haddenham	0.17	0.42	Part of Smallholdings Estate. Car park and picnic site established on area adjacent to Bucks CC tenanted Farm and linking to Farm Trail. Also adjacent to the Tiggywinkles Animal Hospital.
Church Farm Trail (links from Stanbridge Picnic Site above)	Haddenham	0.00	0.00	Permissive trail created around Smallholdings farm to provide countryside access opportunity from Stanbridge Picnic Site.
Thornborough Bridge Picnic Site	Thornborough	0.12	0.30	Small car park and picnic site created on former highway land when new road scheme created. Next to the historic Thornborough Bridge. Links to Thornborough Community Woodland.

Thornborough Community Woodland & Coombs Quarry	Thornborough	68.30	168.77	Part of Smallholdings Estate. Major new community woodland created in late 1990s on former tenanted farm within an area of the County lacking in such access opportunities. Developing mosaic of habitats. Includes old Coombs Quarry of significant geological/educational value (site of regionally geological importance) and designated as a Local Nature Reserve. Adjacent tenanted farm has meadows of high wildlife value accessible via permissive routes from the woodland.
Thorney Park	Iver	18.21	45.00	Lake and grassland site, previously minerals extraction and landfill - bisected by River Colnebrook. 25m deep lake excellent for wildfowl in the winter. Unused car park facilities.
Three Locks Picnic Site	Soulbury	0.56	1.38	Small car park and picnic site created on land acquired for highway improvement. Close to Grand Union Canal and a public house.
Whielden Gate Picnic Site	Amersham	0.30	0.74	Part of Green Belt Estate. Small car park and picnic site. Within Chilterns AONB.
Whiteleaf Hill & Picnic Site	Princes Risborough	11.03	27.26	Part of Green Belt Estate. High profile site on Chilterns escarpment. Major feature is Whiteleaf Cross Scheduled Ancient Monument. Designated a Local Nature Reserve. Also contains other Scheduled Ancient Monuments. Restored through a major Heritage Lottery Funded capital project 2002-2005. Part of a well used access network on the escarpment overlooking Princes Risborough. Ridgeway National Trail and Icknield Way Riders Route runs through. Part classified as Open Access Land. Within Chilterns AONB
