

Bushcraft Days

Terms & Conditions

1. Please read these terms and conditions carefully before completing and returning our booking form. Once a completed booking form has been accepted in writing by Buckinghamshire County Council, all persons named on the booking form (here-after to be known as "participant") will have entered into a binding contract on the basis of these terms and conditions. If you have any questions regarding these conditions, please do not hesitate to contact us.

2. Reasonable care is taken to prevent serious injury and to minimise accidents on all occasions. Our Bushcraft Days are by their very nature, exposed to natural variables, including the weather. Whilst every reasonable effort is made to deal with (indeed to learn from) such contingencies there may be occasions when Buckinghamshire County Council, through no fault of its own, is forced to vary or modify an itinerary at short notice or decides to do so in order to take advantage of natural circumstances.

3. Buckinghamshire County Council accepts its responsibility to alert participants of the risks involved in woodlands and other habitats.. Whilst it is impossible to list all hazards and risks Buckinghamshire County Council have completed a risk assessment (available on request) covering those areas, which in the opinion of Buckinghamshire County Council require the most specific care and attention.

No fires are allowed without the written permission of Buckinghamshire County Council. Even if authorised by Buckinghamshire County Council, no fire shall be left unattended at any time and adequate means of fire fighting must be provided and available at the site of any such fire at all times.

The participant should be advised that axes, bill-hooks, knives or similar are very sharp and are not to be touched or moved without the written permission of an instructor.

Buckinghamshire County Council also insists only knives they provide are used by the participant.on their Bushcraft Days as detailed in the joining instructions.

4. The participant accepts that he/she is fully aware that bushcraft and wilderness living skills days, even under the safest conditions possible, may involve an element of risk. Whilst Buckinghamshire County Council will take every reasonable precaution possible to ensure a safe environment, the participant agrees to accept awareness of these risks.

5. The participant agrees to obey the rules and regulations put into effect to minimise risk to Health and Safety by Buckinghamshire County Council.

6. Buckinghamshire County Council reserves the right to remove any participant from an event, at the discretion of the instructor, if the participant conduct is abusive or inappropriate or they continue to present a risk to Health and Safety.

8. The participant certifies that he/she is physically capable to participate in Bushcraft Days run by Buckinghamshire County Council despite the rigours and risks that may be inherent in such an undertaking.
9. Buckinghamshire County Council reserves the right to alter dates and/or location of Bushcraft Days, if this becomes necessary. Buckinghamshire County Council will endeavour to inform relevant parties as soon as possible.
10. The participant accepts that payment is made in full on booking. No place is guaranteed until payment is received in full.
11. If full payment is not made, Buckinghamshire County Council reserves the right to treat the agreement as cancelled.
12. Minimum age requirement for participation is 18 years of age.
13. In the unlikely event that a participant has cause for complaint, Buckinghamshire County Council would appreciate that it is brought to the attention of a Buckinghamshire County Council representative during the day, in order that corrective action can be taken. However, should a problem not be resolved, a complaint should be made in writing within a reasonable period after the course completion.
14. Although Buckinghamshire County Council Bushcraft Days are led by experienced and capable leaders, it is not intended that any instruction provided to any participant while on a Bushcraft Day will in any way qualify that participant to instruct any third party and no warranty is made to that effect.

All individuals should sign the booking form to accept these Terms and Conditions There is a tick box which they click to confirm they have read and adhere to all our terms and conditions – this is standard on all forms.
