

Local Area Bulletin – Beaconsfield

- At its April meeting the Beaconsfield Forum agreed to use its 2011/12 local priorities budget of £20,000 to provide pump priming support for youth services at the Curzon Centre and the development and refurbishment of sports pitches at Wooburn Green Lane Sports Field.
- A welcome boost to the Beaconsfield Local Area is the announcement that the delegated budget for local transport projects has been doubled for 2011/12. The Beaconsfield Forum now has £50,283 available for use.
