**THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(PARISH OF WHITCHURCH) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2011**

The above Order made on 17 May 2011, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them the footpath from point A on the order map at SP 8044–2026 in an east north easterly direction for approximately 47 metres to point B at SP 8049–2027 as shown by a broken black line and having a width throughout of 1 metre.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at County Hall, Aylesbury during normal opening hours. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from the County Council at a cost of £20.00 at the address given below.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Anne Davies at the address given below not later than 10 August 2011, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Buckinghamshire County Council instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.
