**THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BYWAYS OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC
NOS. 29 AND 42, PARISH OF LITTLE MISSENDEN) DEFINITIVE MAP
MODIFICATION ORDER ORDER 2011**

The above Order made on 21 June 2011, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading to Byways Open to All Traffic the Bridleways from point A on the order map at SU 9240-9719 in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 1356 metres to point B at SU 9333-9814 then in a north north easterly direction for approximately 527 metres to point C at SU 9350-9864 as shown by a brown line and having a width varying between 4.5 and 7.5 metres.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at County Hall, Aylesbury and at Great Missenden Library, High Street, Great Missenden during normal opening hours.

Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from the County Council at a cost of £20.00 at the address given below.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Anne Davies at the address given below not later than 10 August 2011, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Buckinghamshire County Council instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.
