MISSENDEN) DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2011**

Notice of the above Order, made on 4 January 2011, was served on 17 January 2011. It is necessary to re-serve the notice because the route of the Byway Open To All Traffic is unregistered and notice has not been brought to the attention of any possible landowner. If confirmed as made, the order will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading to Byways Open To All Traffic the bridleways described in the schedule below.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at County Hall, Aylesbury and at Great Missenden Library, High Street, Great Missenden during normal opening hours.

Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from the County Council at a cost of £20.00 at the address given below.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order previously submitted remains valid. Should any additional representation or objection be forthcoming it must be sent in writing to Anne Davies at the address given below not later than 11 January 2012, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Buckinghamshire County Council instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food, and Rural Affairs may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.

**SCHEDULE**

**Description of Bridleways to be upgraded to Byways Open To All Traffic**

From point A on the order map at the junction with Nag's Head Lane at SU8855-9978 generally north for approximately 723 metres to point C at SP8860-0046 then generally north east for approximately 402 metres to point D at SP8887-0073 then generally east north east for approximately 515 metres to point E at its junction with the public road section of Whitefield Lane at SP8934-0087 as shown by a brown line and having a width varying between 3.3 and 8.3 metres.
