THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATHS NOS. 6, 7 AND 11 (PART), PARISH OF EDGCOTT) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2011

The above Order, made on 16 August 2011, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the public footpaths described in the schedule below.

A copy of the order and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at County Hall, Aylesbury and Buckingham Library, Verney Close, Buckingham during normal opening hours. Copies of the order and map may be purchased from the County Council at a cost of £20.00 at the address given below.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Head of Legal and Democratic Services at the address given below, not later than 23 September 2011. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Buckinghamshire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

Public Footpath No. 6

A-C

From point A on the order map at its junction with Lawn Hill at SP 6828-2277 in a generally southerly direction for approximately 341 metres to point C at SP 6826-2243 as shown by a bold continuous line.

Public Footpath No. 7

B-E

From point B on the map at its junction with Public Footpath No.6 Edgcott at SP 6827-2274 in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 364 metres to point E at SP 6805-2246 as shown by a bold continuous line.

Public Footpath No. 11

C-D

From point C on the map at its junction with Public Footpath No.6 Edgcott at SP 6826-2243 in a south westerly direction for approximately 253 metres to point D at SP 6808-2226 as shown by a bold continuous line.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS OR WAYS

Public Footpath No. 6

C-F

From point C on the map at its junction with Public Footpath No.11 Edgcott at SP 6826-2243 in a north easterly direction for approximately 372 metres to point F at SP 6856-2265 as shown by a bold broken line and having a width of 2 metres throughout.

Public Footpath No. 7

E-X-G-F

From point E on the map at SP 6805-2246 in a north easterly direction for approximately 305 metres to point G at SP 6828-2265 then in an easterly direction for approximately 281 metres to point F at SP 6856-2265 as shown by a bold broken line and having a width of 2 metres throughout.

Public Footpath No. 11

D-H-I

From point D on the map at SP 6808-2226 in a north easterly direction for approximately 61 metres to point H at SP 6813-2229 then in a south easterly direction for approximately 14 metres to point I at SP 6814-2228 as shown by a bold broken line and having a width of 2 metres throughout.
