PARISH OF TINGEWICK) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2011**

The above Order, made on 2 August 2011, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert the public footpaths and bridleway described in the Schedule below.

A copy of the order and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at County Hall, Aylesbury and Buckingham Library, Verney Close, Buckingham during normal opening hours. Copies of the order and map may be purchased from the County Council at a cost of £20.00 at the address given below.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Head of Legal and Democratic Services at the address given below, not later than 9 September 2011. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Buckinghamshire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.

SCHEDULE

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

A-B-C

From point A on the order map at SP6653-3091 in an easterly direction for approximately 100 metres to point B at SP6543-3092 then for approximately 140 metres in a north easterly direction to point C at SP6552-3103 as shown by a bold continuous line.

D-E-F-C-G

From point D on the map at SP6551-3064 in a north north westerly direction for approximately 173 metres to point E at SP6547-3081 then for approximately 261 metres in a north north easterly direction to point G at SP6553-3105 as shown by a bold continuous line.

F-M

From point F on the map at SP6548-3092 in a north north westerly direction for approximately 92 metres to point M at SP6547-3101 as shown by a bold continuous line.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS OR WAYS

A-H-I-J

From point A on the map at SP6653-3091 in a north easterly direction for approximately 118 metres to point H at SP6544-3095 then for approximately 72 metres in a south easterly direction to point J at SP6548-3090 as shown by a bold broken line and having a width of 2 metres throughout.

D-K-L-J-G

From point D on the map at SP6551-3064 in a northerly direction for approximately 62 metres to point K at SP6552-3070 then for approximately 89 metres in a north north westerly direction to point L at SP6548-3078 then for approximately 284 metres in a generally north north easterly direction to point G at SP6553-3105 as shown by a bold broken line and having a width of 4 metres throughout.

I-M

From point I on the map at SP6544-3095 in a north north easterly direction for approximately 63 metres to point M at SP6547-3101 as shown by a bold broken line and having a width of 2 metres throughout.
