DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2011**

To: OWNERS/OCCUPIERS OF LAND CROSSED BY BYWAY OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC NO. 24, PARISH OF LITTLE MISSENDEN (KNOWN AS FEATHERBED LANE)

The above Order made on 20 September 2011, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them the Byway Open To All Traffic (Featherbed Lane) from point A on the order map at the junction with Beech Tree Road at SU 9065-9741 in a north north westerly direction for approximately 305 metres to point B at SU 9057-9770 then in a north north easterly direction for approximately 400 metres to point C at SU 9063-9809 then in a north westerly direction for approximately 773 metres to point D at the junction with Watchet Lane at SU 9015-9868 as shown by a brown line and having a width varying between 5 and 7 metres.

A copy of the Order and map may be seen free of charge at County Hall, Aylesbury and at Great Missenden Library, High Street, Great Missenden, Bucks, HP16 0AL during normal opening hours. Copies of the Order and map may be purchased from the County Council at a cost of £20.00 at the address given below. Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Anne Davies at the address given below not later than 29 February 2012, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Buckinghamshire County Council instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.
