DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2008

The above Order made on 23 January 2008, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading to byways open to all traffic the bridlevays described in the Schedule below.

A copy of the Order and plan may be seen free of charge at County Hall, Aylesbury and Princes Risborough Library, Bell Street, Princes Risborough, during normal opening hours. Copies of the Order may be purchased from the County Council at a cost of £20.00 at the address given below.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Anne Davies at the address given below, not later than 2 April 2008, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Buckinghamshire County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.

SCHEDULE

Description of bridlevays to be upgraded to byways open to all traffic

Parish of Great and Little Kimble

No 40

From point A on the Order plan at the junction with Aylesbury Road in the parish of Great and Little Kimble south east for 708 metres to point B.

From point D at the Great and Little Kimble/Ellesborough parish boundary south east for 598 metres to point E at the junction with Missenden Road.

No 40A

From point B east south east for 406 metres to point C at the Great and Little Kimble/Ellesborough parish boundary.

Parish of Ellesborough

No 62

From point C in the parish of Ellesborough south east for 266 metres to point D at the Great and Little Kimble/Ellesborough parish boundary.

All have a width of 30 feet (9.14 metres) throughout.
