DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2010**

The above Order made on 22 November 2010, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Adding the footpath from point A on the order plan at the edge of Marlow Mill Pool at SU8552-8608 east south east for approximately 40 metres to point B at its junction with Public Footpath No. 1 Marlow at SU8556-8606 as shown by a bold broken line and having a width of 2.3 metres at point A widening to 4.9 metres at point C at SU8554-8607 then narrowing to 3.8 metres at point B.

A copy of the Order and the Order plan may be seen free of charge at County Hall, Aylesbury and at Marlow Library, Institute Road, Marlow during normal opening hours.

Copies of the Order and plan may be purchased from the County Council at a cost of £20.00 at the address given below.

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Anne Davies at the address given below not later than 4 February 2011, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or to any part of it, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Buckinghamshire County Council instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State, may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.
