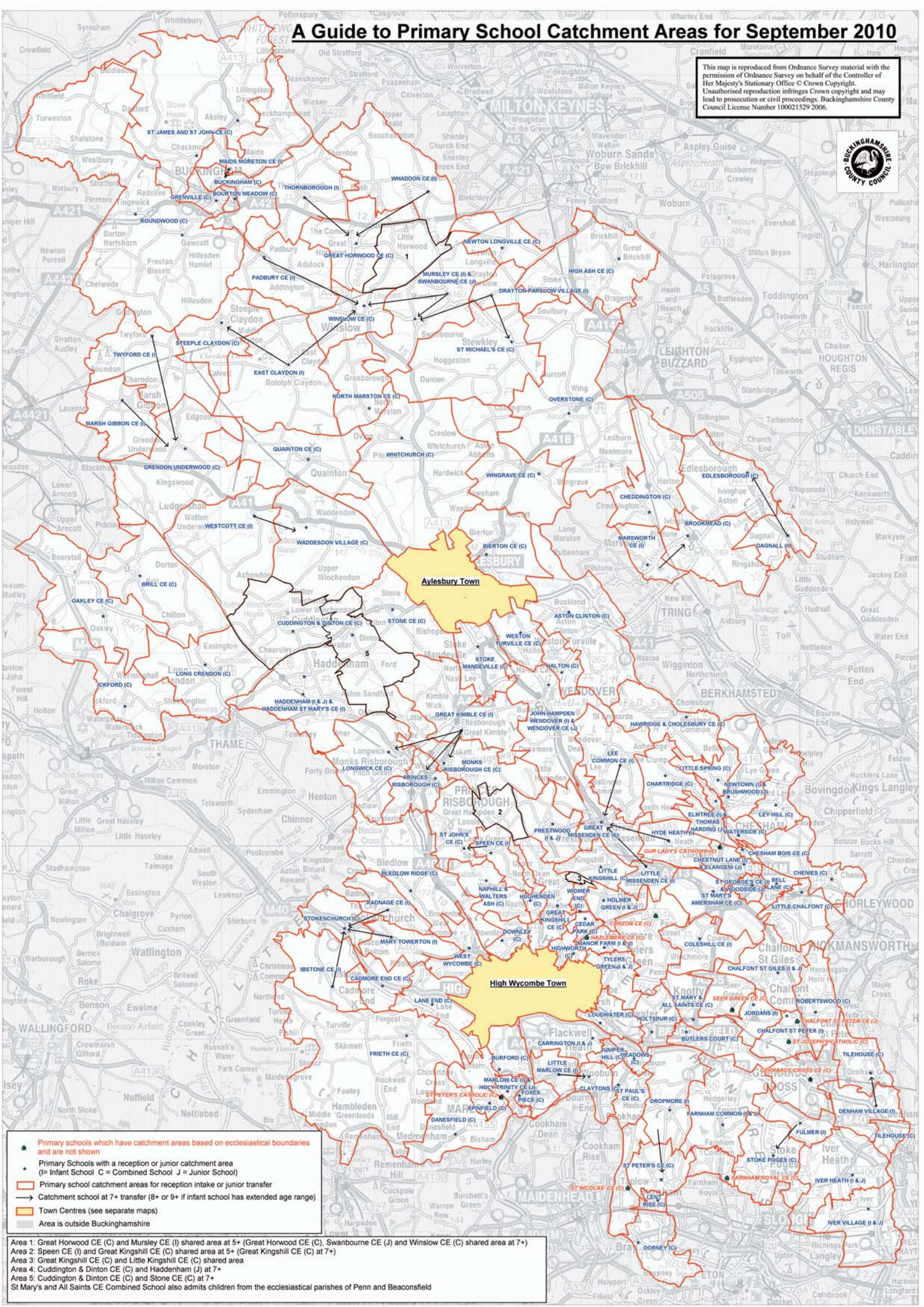


A Guide to Primary School Catchment Areas for September 2010

- Primary school catchment areas for reception intake or junior transfer
- Catchment school at 7+ transfer (8+ or 9+ if infant school has extended age range)
- Town Centres (see separate maps)
- Area is outside Buckinghamshire

 Area 4: Cuddington & Dinton CE (C) and Haddenham (J) at 7+
 Area 5: Cuddington & Dinton CE (C) and Stone CE (C) at 7+
