Information for Parents



What is Pyramid?

Pyramid Clubs are clubs which are run in school, after school once a week for ten weeks.

Up to ten pupils aged between 7-9 are given the opportunity to take part in these clubs which are run by a minimum of three club leaders.

They are designed to help build a child's confidence and self-esteem.

What do the clubs involve?

The clubs offer a variety of activities, including arts, crafts, cooking and games. They aim to increase children's self-confidence by helping them to make friends and talk together in a fun and safe environment.

The children will be encouraged to make choices and come up with ideas about what they would like to do.

Drinks will be supplied at the club and a light snack (taking into account dietary requirements).

Which children will be chosen and how?

Pyramid benefits those children who may be missing out in the hustle and bustle of a busy classroom, perhaps because they are shy, or find it difficult to make friends.

Only ten children can be chosen for each club and this is done through a discussion between the class teacher, the Pyramid co-ordinator and any other adults/professionals already involved with the child.

We acknowledge that as a parent, the knowledge you have about your child is important. You can share your views with us by talking to your child's class teacher. A special meeting for parents will be held later in the term and you will be informed of dates and times.

Cost?

There will be no expense on your part and hopefully no inconvenience, just plenty of opportunity and enjoyment for your child.

Who are the club leaders?

Each club is ran by a minimum of three trained leaders. All leaders are checked with the Criminal Records Bureau and have to provide two references. They are trained before the clubs start and a teacher remains on the school premises during the club sessions.
