

Bus Services in Aylesbury

Town services: Silverrider 1, Blueroute 2, Orangeroute 3, Greenroute 4, 5, Waterrider 6, 6A, Purpleroute 7, Redroute 9

Catching the bus in Aylesbury couldn't be easier. All routes call at the bus station in the centre of town, while many call at the railway station and the High Street. Areas within Aylesbury are served by the Rainbow Routes network. This is a colour coded network of buses running on average every 15–20 minutes between the town's estates and the town centre.

There are also great links for those wishing to travel further afield, with regular services to places such as Oxford, Milton Keynes, High Wycombe, Watford, Leighton Buzzard, Wendover and Buckingham.
