MINIMUM 5 SESSIONS, THE FIRST SESSION SHOULD BE AT LEAST 2 HOURS IN LENGTH AND INCLUDE A CYCLE CHECK AND ASSESSMENT OF LEVEL 1 SKILLS IN THE PLAYGROUND, THEN FOUR 90 MINUTE SESSIONS ON LOCAL ROADS. OR THE EQUIVALENT IN TIME.

- Criteria for funding:
- Funding is available only for KS2 and above (ie Years 5, 6 and 7).
 - £40 funding is available per training place, which includes the award of an 'Official Bikeability Badge' for all students who complete the training. The Bikeability badge will be supplied by the nominated trainer.
 - Full funding is not available
 - Funding to schools will only be approved on confirmation from trainers of numbers and training dates.
 - All schools will be asked to complete and return an evaluation monitoring sheet.
 - It is anticipated that any unspent funding will be reclaimed.
 - It is assumed that schools bidding for the cycle training funding agree to abide by the funding criteria.
