

THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
SPEED LIMIT REVIEW (VARIOUS ROADS, VARIOUS PARISHES IN AREA 2)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 200

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order will be to impose a **40 miles per hour speed restriction** on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below.

This Order provides for the revocation of:-

“The Buckinghamshire County Council (Chesham Road, Chesham and Chartridge)(Speed Limit) Order, 2005”

“The Buckinghamshire County Council (Chapel Road, Aston Clinton and Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards)(40mph Speed Limit) Order, 2005”

“The Buckinghamshire County Council (Various Roads, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards)(40mph Speed Limit) Order, 2005”

“The Buckinghamshire County Council (Chesham Lane, Wendover and The Lee)(40mph Speed Limit) Order, 2005”

“The Buckinghamshire County Council (Chartridge Lane, Chartridge and The Lee)(Speed Limit) Order, 2005”

“The Buckinghamshire County Council (Cholesbury Road, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards)(40mph Speed Limit) Order, 2005”

“The Buckinghamshire County Council (Vale Road, Chesham and Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards)(Speed Limit) Order, 2005”

C72 Chapel Road, Aston Clinton and Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	The entire length from its junction with B4009 Upper Icknield Way, southwards towards its junction with Jenkins Lane for a distance of 4865 metres.
Chambers Green Road, Aston Clinton and Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	From its junction with Jenkins Lane in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 624 metres.
Asheridge Road, Chartridge	From a point 158 metres south east of the centre line of its junction with Widmore Close

	to a point 39 metres west of the centre of its junction with Darvell Drive.
Chesham Road, Chartridge and Chesham	From a point 20 metres north-west of its junction with the entrance to Bellingdon Village Hall north-westwards to its junction with Braziers End.
Hawridge Lane, Chartridge	From its junction with Chesham Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 279 metres.
Swan Bottom/Chartridge Lane, Chartridge and The Lee	From its junction with MC45 in a south easterly direction to a point 230 metres north west from the centre of the junction with Cogdells Lane.
Bottom Road, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	To its junction with Cholesbury Lane which extends to a point 50 metres beyond its junction with Gilberts Hill.
Broomstick Lane (formerly Cider Lane), Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	Entire length.
Cholesbury Lane, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	Extending easterly from its junction with Jenkins Lane and passing through the settlements of Buckland Common, Cholesbury Lane and Hawridge on roads known locally as Springall Hill, Sandpit Hill and the unnamed road through Cholesbury and Hawridge Common to a point 24 metres south-east of the entrance to Nut Hazel Cross Farm.
Cholesbury Road, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	From its junction with Cholesbury Lane in a northerly direction for a distance of 184 metres.
Horseblock, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	From its junction with Cholesbury Lane for a distance of 123 metres.
Little Twye Road, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	Entire length.
Parrotts Lane, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	From its junction with Bottom Road to its junction with Cholesbury Lane.
Pound Lane, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	North westwards from its junction with Cholesbury Lane for a distance of 16 metres.
Stoney Lane, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	Extending 3 metres from its junction with Cholesbury Lane.
Taylor's Lane, Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards	From its junction with Chapel Road in a south westerly direction for a distance of 266 metres.
Chesham Lane (known locally as "Rocky Lane"), Wendover Town and The Lee	From its junction with A413 London Road in an easterly direction to a point 188 metres west of its junction with Kings Lane.
Chesham Lane (known locally as "Rocky Lane"), Wendover Town and The Lee	From its junction with MC45 to a point 641 metres east of its junction with Kings Lane.
