

THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
SPEED LIMIT REVIEW (VARIOUS ROADS, VARIOUS PARISHES IN AREA 2)
(30 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 200

Notice is hereby given that Buckinghamshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of the Order will be to impose a **30 miles per hour speed restriction** on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule below.

This Order provides for the revocation of:-

- “The Buckinghamshire County Council (Vale Road, Chesham and Cholesbury-cum-St. Leonards)(Speed Limit) Order, 2005”
- “The Buckinghamshire County Council (Chartridge Lane, Chartridge and The Lee)(Speed Limit) Order, 2005”
- “The Buckinghamshire County Council (Chesham Lane, Wendover and The Lee)(40mph Speed Limit) Order, 2005”
- “The Buckinghamshire County Council (Asheridge Road, Chartridge)(30mph Speed Limit) Order, 2005”
- “The Buckinghamshire County Council (Widmore Close, Chartridge)(30mph Speed Limit) Order, 2005”
- “The Buckinghamshire County Council (Chesham Road, Chesham and Chartridge)(Speed Limit) Order, 2005”

A copy of the Order and maps showing the lengths of road referred to, together with the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at County Hall, Aylesbury and during normal opening hours at the following: -

- Chesham Library, Elgiva Lane, Chesham.
- Wendover Library, High Street, Wendover.
- Chiltern and South Bucks Area Office, King George V Road, Amersham.

Objections to or support for the proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned by 10 July 2008, marked for the attention of Laura Witney, Legal Assistant, Legal and Democratic Services, County Hall, Aylesbury, Bucks, HP20 1UA.

Under the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 this Council is obliged to make any representations received in response to this notice, open to public inspection.

<u>Name of Road and Parish</u>	<u>Length of Road Affected</u>
Asheridge Road, Chartridge	From a point 158 metres south-east of the centre line of its junction with Widmore Close to a point 107 metres north-westwards of the centre of the entrance to Braid Wood Activity Centre.
Chesham Road, Chartridge and Chesham	From a point 178 metres north-west of the centre of its junction with Little Hivings, to a point 20 metres north-west of its junction with the entrance to Bellingdon Village Hall.
MC2 Chartridge Lane, Chartridge and The Lee	From a point 169 metres south-east of its junction with The Warren to a point 230

	metres north west from the centre of the junction with Cogdells Lane.
Widmore Close, Chartridge	From its junction with Asheridge Road for a distance of 125 metres.
Vale Road, Chesham	From a point 28 metres south of its junction with Popular Close to a point 24 metres south-east of its junction with the entrance to Nut Hazel Cross Farm.
Chesham Lane (known locally as "Rocky Lane"), Wendover Town and The Lee	From a point 188 metres west of its junction with Kings Lane to a point 641 metres in an easterly direction.
Kings Lane, Wendover Town and The Lee	From its junction with Chesham Lane (known locally as "Rocky Lane") for a distance of 43 metres in a southerly direction.
