

THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL SPEED LIMIT REVIEW
(VARIOUS ROADS, VARIOUS PARISHES IN AREA 9)
(50 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2008

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1)(a), (2) and section 9(4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and having regard to Section 122 of the Act, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The Buckinghamshire County Council Speed Limit Review (Various Roads, Various Parishes in Area 9)(50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2008" and shall come into operation on 1st September 2008.
3. The Orders specified in Schedule 2 of this Order are hereby revoked in their entirety.

SCHEDULE 1

<u>Name of Road and Parish</u>	<u>Description</u>
A40 known as White Hill, Wooburn Moor and London Road/Wycombe End, Beaconsfield, Beaconsfield/Wooburn	Between a point 167 metres east of its junction with Whitehouse Lane, Loudwater and a point 301 metres west of its junction with Windsor End, Beaconsfield.
