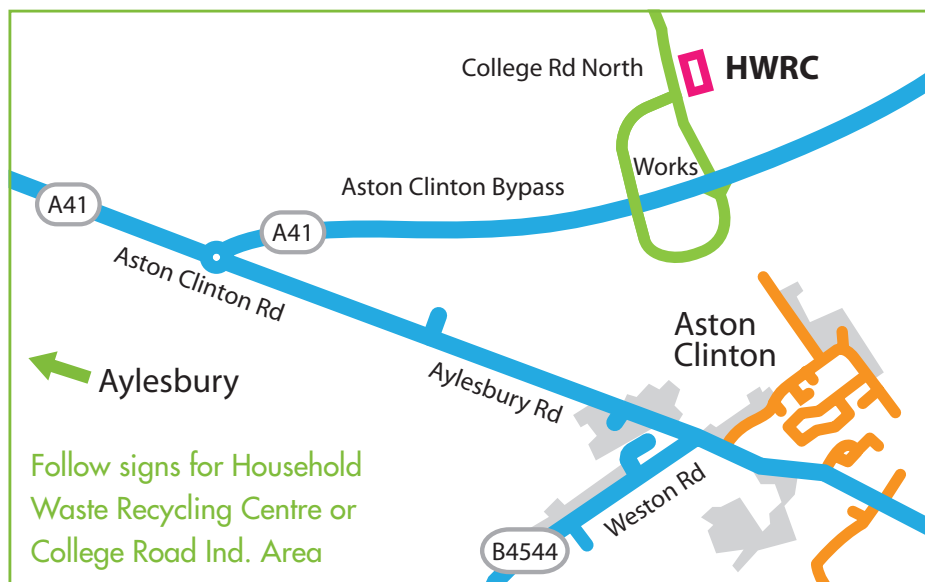


With over 40 parking spaces, the Aston Clinton HWRC is open seven days a week, from 8am – 6pm in the summer and 8am – 5pm in the winter.
