

Duty of Care (Householders)

If you pass your household waste (including DIY waste) to anyone else, you MUST check that they are legally authorised to take it.

If your waste is illegally dumped and you did not check for a waste carrier's licence, you could be fined up to £5,000.

To check the waste carrier is authorised to take your waste, contact the Environment Agency:

Site and Permit Conditions

Any person who disposes of trade waste at a HWRC may be committing a criminal offence for which he or she may be prosecuted and will be liable to pay the council the necessary fee for waste disposed. Dedicated trade facilities are provided for the legitimate disposal of trade waste (charges apply).

Permits are only issued to Buckinghamshire residents. Site staff will retain all expired permits and details of any suspected trade waste being deposited will be forwarded to the permit team for investigation. Buckinghamshire County Council reserves the right to use this information to review site usage and refuse the issue of permits on the basis of false or misleading information. Such information may be forwarded to the Environment Agency, HM Revenue and Customs, Trading Standards and other law enforcement agencies for further action. All information will be stored on a database registered under the Data Protection Act 1998.

The permit scheme is regularly reviewed and conditions may be subject to change.

Waste left outside the HWRC gates will be regarded as fly tipping. Individuals caught fly tipping will be liable for prosecution.

Household Waste Recycling Centres:

Sites are open 7 days a week, 9am to 6pm between 1st April and 30th September and 9am to 5pm between 1st October and 31st March. Sites are closed on 25th, 26th December and 1st January. Trade facilities are open Monday to Friday.

A permit scheme is in place for householders depositing waste at the Household Waste Recycling Centres.

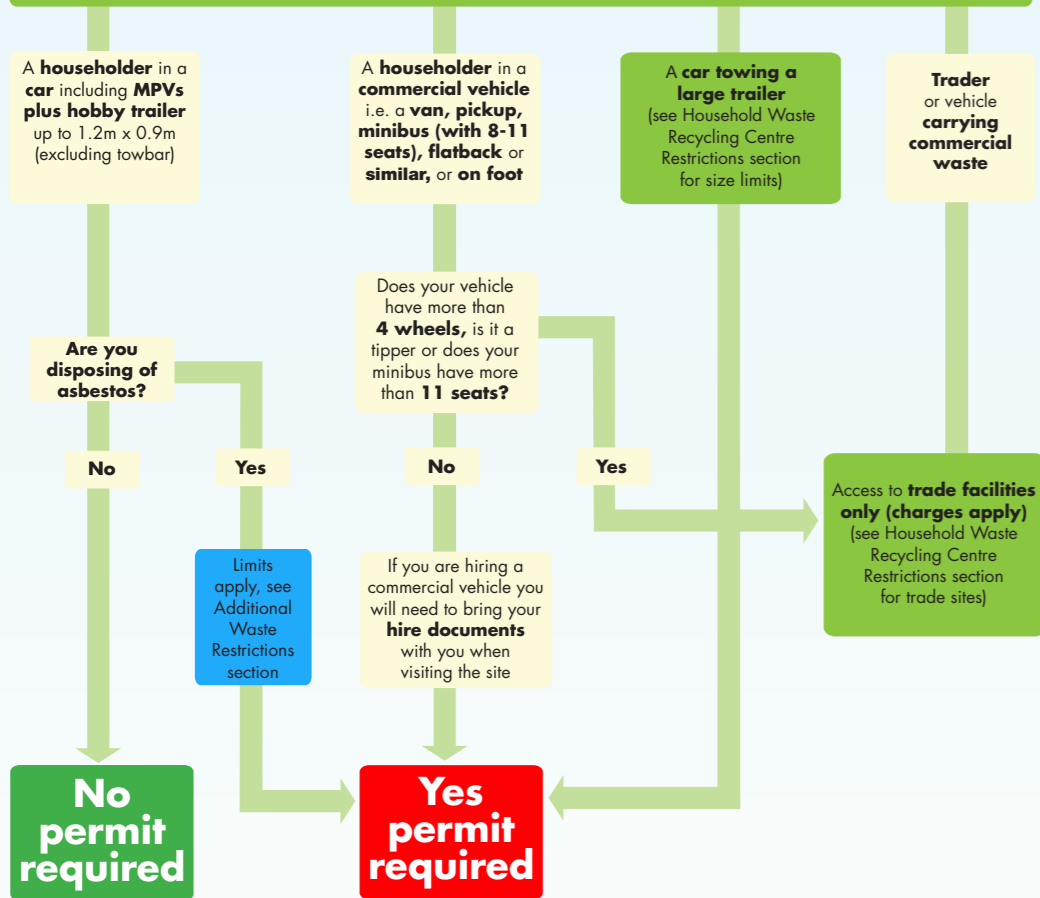
YOU MAY REQUIRE A PERMIT!

Please note trade waste is only accepted at certain sites.

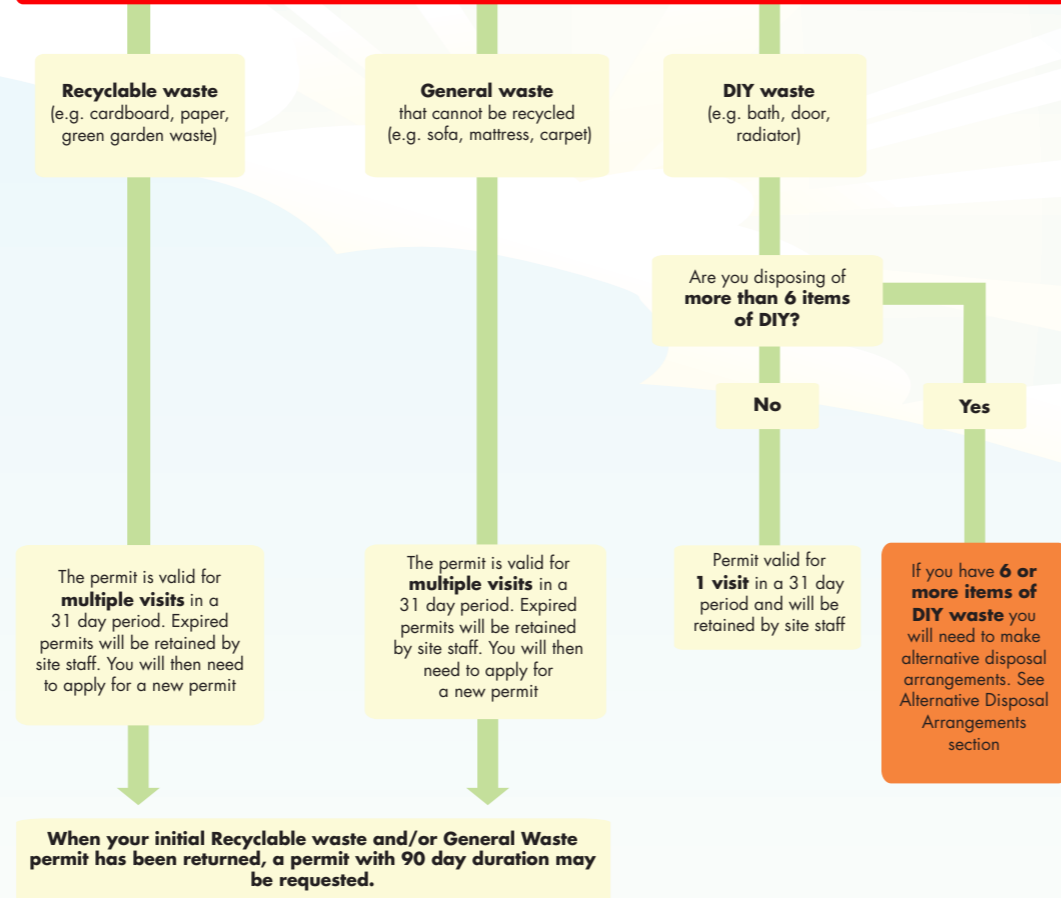


The permit scheme was introduced to Buckinghamshire's Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRC) in 2006 to increase recycling, reduce congestion and prevent non-household waste being deposited at the sites. If you require a permit or more information please contact the Waste Permit Line before visiting the site. Permits are easy to obtain and free to householders.

Do you need a permit?



The following permits are issued to householders



Additional Waste Restrictions

Under this policy, householders will be able to dispose of the following items in any one calendar year. Householders must make alternative arrangements to dispose of quantities in excess of these limits:

- 2 fridges
- 2 freezers
- 2 televisions
- 2 computer monitors
- 4 fluorescent tubes
- 2 car batteries
- 10 litres of engine oil
- 5 litres of garden chemicals*
- Asbestos* (4 sheets approx. 2.4m x 0.9m or 3 normal bin bags). Please ensure it is double wrapped in plastic and taped

Alternative Disposal Arrangements for DIY Waste

- Hiring a skip
- Using one of the waste bag services available at DIY stores
- Using the council's Trade Facility Sites (see Household Waste Recycling Centre Restrictions section)
- Contacting a private waste disposal or recycling facility
