The UKYP aims to give young people between the ages of 11-18 a voice which will be listened to by local and national government and other agencies who have an interest in the views and needs of young people.

There are 3 members of the Youth Parliament (MYP's) representing Aylesbury, Wycombe and Chiltern and South Bucks along with 3 Deputy MYP's who are elected by young people.

Any young person who lives or goes to school in Buckinghamshire is eligible to take part either as a candidate or to vote.
